

Bromley-by-Bow North Exhibition

You are invited to a public exhibition of the revised regeneration proposals for the Bromley-by-Bow North area. We have revised the scheme following feedback received during the previous planning application consultation process in September 2011. The exhibition is being organised by John Thompson & Partners on behalf of the Housing Associations East Thames Group and Southern Housing Group ahead of the amended application being submitted in April 2012.

The new scheme includes the following changes:

- The location of some of the buildings have been moved to create a better organised space
- Creates useable open space
- Reduces storey height across the main part of the scheme
- Provides front doors onto the towpath
- The look of the buildings have been improved by simplifying the design
- The overall number of homes has fallen from 790 units to 740 units

The exhibition will be open to everybody and will provide an opportunity to view the revised proposals for the site and leave comments. Members of the design team and representatives from East Thames Group and Southern Housing Group will be on hand to talk through the proposals and answer questions.
