Previous work has identified growth and place priorities for Bodmin. This work was informed by earlier consultations and is outlined in the Cornwall Local Plan and the associated Site Allocations document. However, significant events, such as the Climate Change Emergency and the Covid Pandemic have had a profound impact on residents, businesses and local communities in recent years.

With significant changes in the way we live and work and a concerted effort to support climate change and sustainable community resilience, we want to understand what makes Bodmin unique, the challenges the local community are facing and capture the opportunities for the town centre and identify the community's ambitions to deliver a vibrant and sustainable town centre.

The Bodmin 2030 and Beyond Vision, which was launched in 2019, identifies the long-term ambitions for the town as 'an **attractive, thriving town centre** which has evolved into a community hub offering a variety of daytime and evening meeting places and experiences as well as retail opportunities.'

Cornwall Council has committed to work with local partners to progress the next steps to understand how this ambition can be delivered. The first of these steps is a community planning event called a Charrette, in which we are supported by JTP architects who are specialist architects, urban designers and community planners.

What is a Charrette?

A Charrette is an open, multi-day, interactive planning and co-design event. It is an opportunity to share local knowledge and create a new vision through facilitated workshops, walkabouts and hands-on planning groups.

Participation is on a drop-in-basis - there is no need to pre-register - you can stay for a short while, a few hours or the whole event if you are able to.

Report back presentation

After the public workshop days, the JTP-led team will analyse and summarise the outcomes and draw up a vision for the town centre, including an illustrative masterplan, with a focus on realistic routes to delivery. This will be presented back to the local community at 6.45pm on Tuesday evening 22 March 2022.
