CENTRAL WINCHESTER REGENERATION

Architects and masterplanners JTP have developed a draft Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) for adoption by Winchester City Council. It sets out a vision and planning and urban design framework for the future development of the Central Winchester Regeneration (CWR) area. The document will, once adopted, provide design and planning policy guidance for development in the CWR area and will supplement the Winchester District Local Plan Part 1 (2013) and Part 2 (2017).

Pending approval from the Council's Cabinet on 6 December 2017, formal consultation on the draft SPD will commence on 11 December 2017 until 5 February 2018. The document was made available to the public on 31 October 2017 and so comments can also be made prior to 11 December 2017 if people prefer to do that. Comments received before 6 December 2017 will be noted at Cabinet and carried forward into the formal consultation period. Comments received between 6 and 11 December 2017 will also be carried forward into the formal consultation period.
