You are invited to the Maidenhead Vision Community Planning Day to help shape a new Vision and Charter for Maidenhead Town Centre.

Background

With several regeneration projects underway in Maidenhead Town Centre, and a number in the pipeline, it is important that the vision for the future ensures the town centre continues to develop and meet the needs of the community now and in the future. JTP has been appointed by the Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead (RBWM) to work with residents and stakeholders to draw up a Placemaking Vision and Charter for the town centre.

Community Planning Day

The Community Planning Day will be a chance to share local knowledge and contribute to creating the new Vision and Charter through facilitated workshops, walkabouts and hands-on planning groups. There will also be an exhibition explaining the background to the town centre regeneration and team members will be on hand to answer questions.

The day will start at 10.00am with hour long guided walking groups - if you would like to join a group please if you can let us know in advance by emailing community@jtp.co.uk.

Participation in the day of workshops starting at 11.15am is on a drop-in basis - there is no need to pre-register - and you can stay for a short while, a couple of hours or for the whole event if you are able to.

Report Back Presentation

Following the public workshop day, the JTP team will analyse and summarise the outcomes and draw up an illustrated Vision and draft Charter for Maidenhead. This will be presented back to the local community on Tuesday 14 January 2020 from 6.45pm - 8.30pm at St Mary's Church.

Vision and Charter Document

Following the Report Back, JTP will prepare a Vision and Charter document for further consideration prior to submission to the RBWM and partner organisations.

The new Vision and Charter will describe and illustrate the future of Maidenhead Town Centre and inform developers about the expectations and aspirations of the community. It will also help guide a number of other future areas of work, including the future transport and parking strategies and public realm design standards.
